Officers of the Toccoa Police Department received an average of 70 hours of training each in 2009. This is well above the minimal state requirement of 20 hours. The following are classes instructed by the Toccoa Police Department or local guest instructors: Intermediate and Advanced Incident Command System, Health and Wellness Awareness for police personnel, Advanced Crime Scene Processing, Defensive Driving and Vehicle Pursuits, Use of Deadly Force, Tazer Certification, Specialized Patrol Techniques, Child Abuse Investigations, Child Passenger Safety Seat Technician, Crime Scene Technician, DWI-Standardized Field Sobriety Testing, First Responder Certification, Radar Certification, Radar Re-certification, LIDAR (Laser Speed Detection) Certification, Elder Abuse, 12 Critical Tasks Training for State Certification, SWAT Level 1 and 2.
